The Tiverton Wastewater District (TWWD) is requesting proposals for Sewer Pump Station Operation and Maintenance Services and Sewer System Emergency Response. Tiverton Wastewater District (TWWD) will select highly qualified Contractors (hereafter referred to as the CONTRACTOR or APPLICANT or FIRM), who can provide a quick response, quality repairs, and a high level of customer service and performance in all work efforts. Each applicant submitting proposals must be lawfully engaged in the practice of wastewater pump station and sewer system operation and maintenance, in good standing, and with specific experience in the type of services requested herein within the State of Rhode Island.

One (1) original and two (2) copies of the Proposal must be received from applicants by the TWWD **no later than 2:00 PM on June 2, 2026** to be eligible for consideration by the TWWD. Each proposal shall be submitted in a sealed envelope to TWWD located at 400 Fish Road, Tiverton, RI 02878. Bids should be clearly marked: **BID PROPOSAL FOR: TWWD Sewer Pump Station Operation and Maintenance Services and Sewer System Emergency Response.**

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR SEWER PUMP STATION OPERATION AND

The Tiverton Wastewater District (TWWD) is seeking proposals from qualified firms (hereafter referred to as the CONTRACTOR or APPLICANT or FIRM), to perform Sewer Pump Station (also referred to as STATION or FACILITY) Operation and Maintenance Services and Sewer System Emergency Response for the period of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, with bids required for the option of extending the contract for two subsequent fiscal years. Interested firms should respond to this request on, or before, the time due for submission.

BACKGROUND

The Tiverton Wastewater District manages, operates and maintains the wastewater collection system that serves portions of the Town of Tiverton, Rhode Island. Under an Intermunicipal Agreement, the TWWD system discharges to the City of Fall River, MA Municipal Wastewater Treatment Facility.

Sewer infrastructure generally uses gravity to move wastewater from a higher source location to a lower destination for treatment. This is possible when existing elevations allow waste to flow down from the customer to the ultimate point of treatment. When elevations do not allow gravity flow, the alternative is to locate a pump station in a low area. Wastewater flows from individual customers down to the pump stations by gravity flow, and then each pump station pumps the wastewater that it receives up to the nearest gravity manhole. TWWD operates 4 such pump stations. Failure of a pump station would leave the customers in the area without service. This is not an acceptable outcome.

The 4 pump stations that TWWD operates are located at Mill Street, Schooner Drive, Industrial Way, and Blackbird Court (see Appendix A for additional information). Each station requires regular routine operational maintenance and occasional emergency response services to avoid any interruptions in customer service. TWWD is requesting proposals for a contractor to provide these services.

ENGAGEMENT OVERVIEW

GENERAL

There is no expressed or implied obligation for the Tiverton Wastewater District to reimburse responding firms for any expenses incurred in preparing proposals in response to this request.

Any representations made with the submission will be relied upon and if proven to be false will be grounds for termination of the contract, if awarded. False representations will also be grounds for forfeiture of all payments under the contract. This will not limit the TWWD from seeking any other legal or equitable remedies.

It is expected that the selection of a firm will be completed by **June 15, 2026**. Following the notification of the selected firm, it is expected a contract will be executed between both parties by **July 1, 2026**. The selected firm be available for work upon signature of a contract agreement until **June 30, 2027**.

SCOPE OF WORK AND PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

1.1. Basic Services

The Contractor shall, in accordance with Applicable Law, provide the basic services set forth below, as may be amended in writing from time to time by mutual agreement of the Parties ("Basic Services"):

1. Make one visit to each Station, not to exceed four (4) hours per day, (1) days per week, during Normal Business Hours.

2. Perform the following routine operations at each of the four (4) pump Stations. Mill St., Blackbird Ct., Schooner Dr., Industrial Way.
 - a. Inspect the pump station, record pump run hours, inspect floats, and ensure pumps are operating properly, and recommend cleaning to the TWWD;
 - b. Check mechanical equipment (e.g., motors, pumps, etc.) and recommend preventive maintenance of equipment (e.g., change oil, grease, wet well cleaning) to the TWWD's staff.
 - c. Inspect the emergency generator weekly, record test run hours, check oil and fuel levels and inform the TWWD's staff when oil and fuel levels need replenishing.
3. Perform the following routine operation at the Foote Street and Lee Way Metering Stations.
 - a. Inspect the metering station, record the flow totalizer reading, and recommend cleaning to the TWWD.
 - b. Check mechanical equipment and recommend preventive maintenance of equipment to the TWWD's staff.
4. Provide an answering service twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week, which will include monitoring of the TWWD Mission Communications pump station alarm/monitoring system and notify Contractor's operator of any alarm conditions at the Facility.
5. Update Preventative Maintenance Schedule Based on Manufacturer's requirements, and costs to carry out the service.
6. Maintain a site visit journal and record operational activities and note general observations of the Station conditions, including equipment serviced, and noticeable concerns with the control building and grounds.
7. Submit a monthly status report of the Stations via electronic means, addressing unusual conditions of equipment, process, building, and grounds, and recommend to the TWWD any necessary repairs, upgrades, maintenance, process, or Station improvements.

1.2 Additional Pump Station and Sewer System Services

In addition to the Basic Services, Contractor shall be responsible for providing the goods and services more particularly set forth below, as may be required or as requested by the TWWD ("Additional Services"):

1. Provide an answering service, twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week, which will receive sewer system overflow notification from the Tiverton Police or Tiverton Wastewater District.

2. Notify TWWD of pump station alarm condition or sewer system overflow notification received from the Tiverton Police (prior to responding if so requested). Within 2 hours of an alarm or notification arrive at the pump station or overflow location and:
3. Notify the TWWD of the Facility's condition if the situation requires work or may result in possible violations and take immediate action, to prevent loss of limb, life, property or unpermitted discharge (during normal business hours).
4. If there is an equipment malfunction or failure that does not threaten loss of limb, life, property or un-permitted discharge, notify the TWWD and request authorization to take reasonable actions to restore Facility to normal operation or arrange for contingency operation, such as "pump and haul". The costs of such restorative actions shall be borne by the TWWD. If the TWWD or the TWWD's representative cannot be reached or refuse to authorize this corrective action and a permit violation occurs, it shall be deemed an Uncontrollable Circumstance and the TWWD shall indemnify Contractor for all loss and expense incurred by Contractor. The TWWD shall supply Contractor with twenty-four (24) hour emergency numbers for the TWWD representatives.
5. Contractor shall not be responsible for fines or penalties from the RIDEM as a result of the TWWD delaying approval or impeding the progress of Repairs or Replacement of failed equipment.
6. Attend meetings with the TWWD to report on the Stations operation and maintenance or to provide general recommendations regarding Facility operations and maintenance, when requested by the TWWD.
7. Inspection of sewer service connections for compliance with TWWD Sewer Connection Permits and providing written reports and as built sketches.
8. During periods of extended power outages, provide emergency power and periodically pump down 78 E/one grinder pumps in the Riverside neighborhood of Tiverton that are equipped with a 240 V quick connect. The generator provided must be 240V and rated to start a 6500-watt load minimum.

1.3. Excluded Services

The TWWD shall be solely responsible for the arrangement and implementation of those services and items set forth below ("Excluded Services"):

1. Pay the cost for vendor and repair shops costs for spare parts, equipment or the cost accrued by Contractor to schedule and carry out.
2. Maintenance, Repair and Replacement of all Stations equipment or the cost accrued by Contractor to schedule and carry out.

3. Pay the contractor's cost for hauling and disposal of all grease and solids. Or the cost accrued by Contractor to schedule and carry out.
4. Provide and pay for all Capital Improvements at the Facility.
5. Pay the costs for annual calibration of flow meter(s), or the cost accrued by Contractor to schedule and carry out.
6. Pay the costs for annual servicing of emergency generator(s), including replenishing of fuel or the cost accrued by Contractor to schedule and carry out.
7. Perform building maintenance, lawn mowing, snow removal, leaf and weed removal, trimming, and removal of trees and shrubbery or the cost accrued by Contractor to schedule and carry out.
8. Maintain sewer collection system, including cleaning, unclogging blockages, and repairs.
9. Pay all utility costs, including, but not limited to, natural gas, propane, water, sewer, electric, telephone, electronic monitoring and trash associated with Contractor's operation of the Facility.
10. Certified Personnel and Subcontractors.
Contractor shall provide the Basic Services under the direct supervision of Contractor. Personnel who possess valid wastewater operator certifications as required by Applicable Law; or if no such certification is required, by personnel Contractor deems qualified to perform the Basic Services. The TWWD acknowledges and agrees that Contractor may retain subcontractors to assist Contractor in the performance of Basic Services and the Additional Services, who will be bound to the same duties and obligations for performance of the services as Contractor. The use of subcontractors shall not relieve Contractor of its responsibility or obligations under this Agreement.
11. Safety Standards
All work carried out by Contractor and its subcontractors shall be performed in accordance with Federal Occupational Health and Safety standards as well as any applicable state regulations.

Addenda to this RFP, if any, including written answers to questions received prior to the Deadline for Submission of Questions, will be provided directly to the Proposer's e-mail address on file at TWWD. Each Contractor shall ascertain prior to submitting their Proposal that he/she has received all Addenda issued.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

Contractor shall include the following items in the Company's Proposal:

1. Qualifications:

Using the form in Appendix B state the full name and address of your organization and, if applicable, the branch office or other subordinate element that will perform, or assist in performing, the work. Also, identify the person that will coordinate with TWWD in case of an emergency and estimate the amount of time needed to visit a proposed work site after being notified of an emergency. Briefly describe the history of the firm and the types of services provided. Identify areas of technical and skilled trade expertise which make the firm qualified for this work. Provide contact information.

Contractor shall describe, using Appendix C, any pending litigation the company is involved in, if any. Also describe any litigation the company was involved in during the previous three years.

Contractor shall provide the Basic Services under the direct supervision of Contractor personnel who possess valid wastewater operator certifications as required by Applicable Law; or if no such certification is required, by personnel Contractor deems qualified to perform the Basic Services. The DISTRICT acknowledges and agrees that Contractor may retain subcontractors to assist Contractor in the performance of the Basic Services and the Additional Services, who will be bound to the same duties and obligations for

performance of the services as Contractor. The use of subcontractors shall not relieve Contractor of its responsibility or obligations under this Agreement.

2. Employees:

Identify the individuals or classes of employees that will be employed in the work. Show where these personnel will be physically located during the time they are engaged in the work. Indicate which of these individuals you consider key to the successful completion of the type of work anticipated. Provide all contact information including cell phone numbers and emails.

Resumes or qualifications (maximum of one page per individual) may be submitted in this section. Qualifications and capabilities of any sub-consultants must also be included.

3. Relevant Experience:

Provide the details of the Contractor's recent relevant projects and past performance of the Contractor and its team members on comparable work. This item should cover, at a minimum, the substantive nature of comparable projects, when they were performed, the team members assigned, equipment used and the total contracted cost. Contractors are required to give sufficient information of their experiences to permit TWWD to understand and verify the exact nature of the contributions made by the Contractor to the projects listed.

4. Bid Form:

In addition to the qualification proposal as discussed above, the Contractor shall complete the Bid Form provided in Appendix D.

Bids are to include the following items: labor rates for all personnel proposed to work on this project and shall include any state and federal tax and employee salaries, benefits, and overhead. Contractor overhead and profit shall be included in the labor and equipment rates provided.

Bids shall be provided for each of three years. Contract extensions beyond the first fiscal year (July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027) shall be subject to approval by the Tiverton Wastewater District Board of Directors.

The Contractor will be obligated to use the rates included in their proposal to generate the invoices for each individual task solicited by TWWD under this Contract. Back-up documentation for material costs shall be provided with all invoices.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

The proposals will be accepted or rejected according to the following selection criteria:

- 1) Professional Qualifications, Team and Experience

2) Rates proposed.

TWWD may request additional information and/or elect to interview Contractors during the selection process. Multiple Contractors may be selected for this on-call Contract based on TWWD's anticipated workload.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:

By submitting a proposal, the Contractor authorizes TWWD to undertake such Investigation as may be necessary to verify the Contractor's qualifications and reputation. The Contractor may be requested to execute a release(s) in favor of third parties who have relevant information.

The Tiverton Wastewater District reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, to waive technical or legal deficiencies, and to negotiate or accept any proposal that it may deem to be in the best interest of TWWD.

The proposal will become part of the Contract between TWWD and the successful Contractor.

EXECUTION OF WORK:

All work, labor, and materials shall comply with the applicable sections of TWWD's Standard Specifications and the RIDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Latest Edition. All necessary federal, state, and local permits and licenses required for the safe completion of the work shall be obtained and kept available at the work site for inspection.

Equipment offered and utilized must be in good mechanical condition and not require excessive maintenance, repair, or create excessive downtime that jeopardizes the Contractor's ability to complete the work.

The Contractor shall work continuously, until the site has been secured and the flow of sanitary sewage is restored and approved by the Engineer.

If required due to specific site conditions other items of work may become necessary. TWWD must authorize in advance work not covered by existing agreements. Additional items of work or materials may be to be incorporated into change orders or addenda to those agreements. No compensation will be granted without advance TWWD written authorization.

INSURANCE

For the contract duration, the Contractor shall be required to procure and maintain insurance coverage for not less than the following amounts or greater:

TWWD shall be named as additionally insured under the Contractor's insurance coverage. The Contractor is required to maintain a current, valid certificate of insurance on file at TWWD at all times throughout the contract duration.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT:

Charges for labor and equipment proposed at an hourly rate shall be calculated and billed to the nearest one-quarter hour increment.

Work shall be measured as shown in the Bid Form and as otherwise specified herein.

Overtime rates will be paid for manpower only.

INVOICES:

Invoices for work performed by the Contractor will be reviewed and approved by the TWWD's Executive Director. Payment will be made by check for approved invoices.

All invoices shall be submitted within thirty days of the date that the work is substantially complete. A separate invoice shall be provided for each job. The invoice shall include the street address or location description for the job and a description of the work.

Notwithstanding any contrary provision set forth herein, if any Contractor fails to submit invoices timely, as noted above, TWWD shall be authorized to submit to the Contractor a proposed invoice for the services rendered by the Contractor. If the Contractor then fails to submit its final invoice within seven (7) days of receipt of the proposed invoice, then

the TWWD's proposed invoice shall be final and the Contractor shall not be entitled to recoup any funds in excess of the TWWD's invoice. Further, if the final invoice from the Contractor proves to be less than the amount of the TWWD's invoice, then any excess shall be returned to the TWWD.

If the TWWD shall, at any time during the performance of this agreement, deem it expedient or it shall become necessary for the TWWD to abandon or involuntarily defer any work under this agreement or any part thereof before completion of any work to be rendered hereunder, the Contractor shall be entitled to compensation for any uncompensated work performed prior to such time.
